**E-P.1 - NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROJECT TO BE LOCATED IN (OR THAT WILL IMPACT ON) A
FLOODPLAIN OR WETLANDS**

Date of Publication: July 25, 2013

The **City of Bisbee** is proposing to conduct a street improvement (CDBG #129-12) to be funded with **Community Development Block Grant** funds received through the Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH).

The City of Bisbee has determined that this proposed project lies in (or will impact) a floodplain/wetlands and thus is publishing this notice in compliance with Executive Orders 11988 or 11990 and the Floodplain Management Wetlands Protection Guidelines adopted by the Water Resources Council.

Park Avenue, between 1st and 2nd Street, is a critical point in the entire neighborhood as storm water drainage flows from the Pittsburgh Ave. alley, which is at a higher elevation, to the low laying area on Park Ave. through the back yards of residences on Park. To alleviate this condition, water flowing to Park will be diverted to 1st street from the Pittsburgh St. alley by drainage pipe, catch basins and curbing. Construction on this alley will consist of approximately 315 lf of wedge curbing, 410 sq. yds. of asphalt, 3 new catch basins, and 125 lf. of 12" HDPE drainage pipe. Water will flow down 1st St. and be discharged into existing drainage facilities to the south near Bisbee Road. Additionally, 750 lf of 16' wide (1400 sq. yds.) of existing asphalt shall be pulverized and paved on Whelan Ave.; 630 lf. X 12' wide (850 sq.yds) of existing asphalt shall be pulverized and paved on Campbell Ave.; and 420 x 15" wide (700 sq. yds.) of existing asphalt shall be pulverized and paved on Park Ave.

The **City of Bisbee** has additional information available on this project, which can be reviewed at City Hall, 118 Arizona Street, Bisbee, Arizona, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., which is handicapped accessible or persons with special accessibility needs may contact Stephen J. Pauken, City Manager. Interested persons can also call (520) 432-6000 for additional information about this proposed project. The City is now considering potential alternative sites, potential flood impact on the proposed project, and potential mitigation to minimize flood hazard or wetlands impact.

Written comments on this proposed project are invited and should be submitted by **August 9, 2013** to the City of Bisbee, 118 Arizona Street, Bisbee, AZ 85603. All such comments will be taken into account by the City prior to its decision on the proposed project.
